Firearms Safety Rules

Firearms must never be pointed at another person for any reason.

Except when on the firing point, rifles must have the bolt/action open and breech flag/plug inserted.

Dry firing must only be carried out with firearm pointed down range.

No firearm is to be loaded other than on the firing point, with the muzzle pointed down range.

When loading bolt action rifles, push the round fully home. Do not use the bolt to load the rifle, as round may fire accidentally.

Once a firearm is loaded, keep finger clear of the trigger until you are ready to fire.

All loaded firearms must be kept pointed down range.

All firearms must be unloaded before leaving the range, with bolt/action open and breech flag/plug inserted.

If a firearm malfunction, seek assistance of the RCO/SO.

In the case of a misfire, count to 30 seconds before opening the breech (the round may fire with delayed action). Any misfires, or live rounds found on the firing point, should be handed to the RCO/SO for safe disposal.

Wash your hands after handling ammunition due to high lead content.

THE RANGE OFFICER IS AUTHORISED TO ORDER ANY PERSON OFF THE RANGE WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THESE RULES.

A duty Range Officer will control the range, his/her instructions must be obeyed.

The range officer is responsible for ensuring all doors are locked before firing.

No personnel may go forward of the firing point with the permission of the Range Officer, RCO/SO.

No firearm shall be discharged until permission has been given to commence "Go on"

On the order "STOP, STOP, STOP", firers will make weapons safe (safety catch) and lay down.

At end of shooting detail, all weapons must be unloaded and made safe with breech flags/plugs inserted. Empty cartridge cases should be collected.

Range attendees should stay inside range until end of detail.

All novice shooters and juniors must be accompanied by a competent instructor.

Eating, Drinking and Smoking are not permitted in the range.

All members in range MUST wear ear protection and is recommended to wear eye protection.
